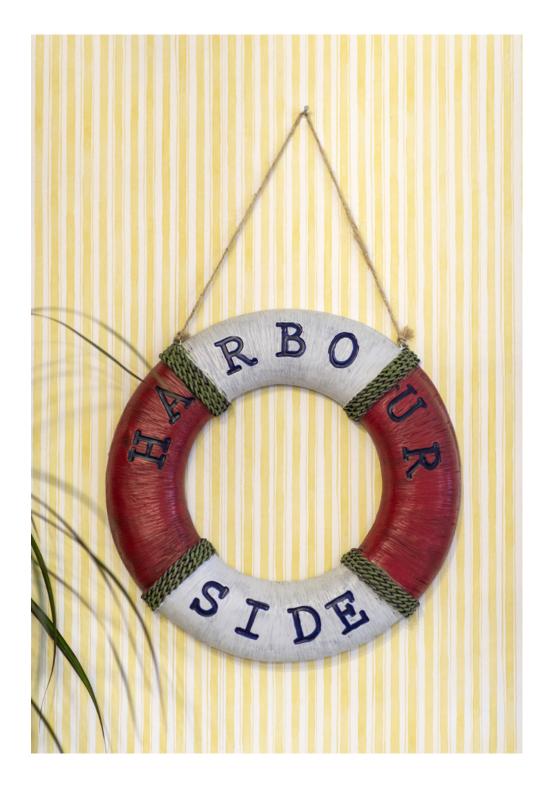

During their stay with us, guests enjoy 5 star dining, luxury accommodation and a bespoke care package to perfectly match their needs.









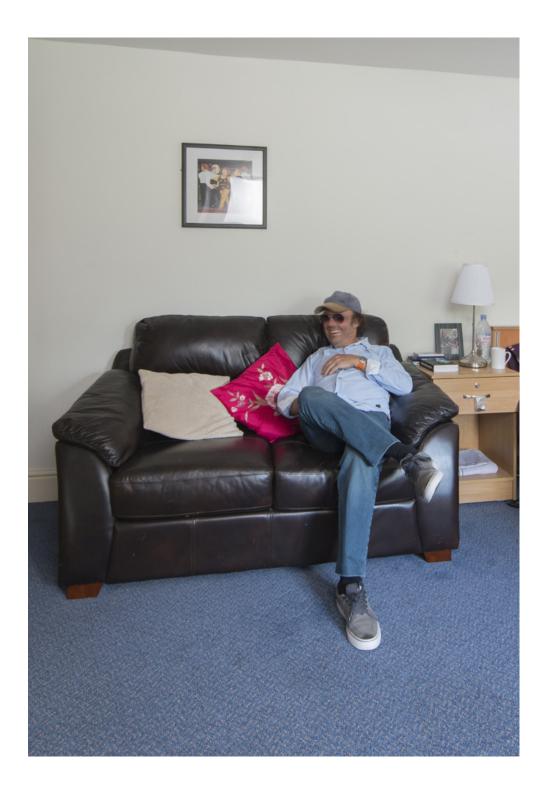
A CLOSE-KNIT INTIMATE ENVIRONMENT

ATTENTIVE, PROFESSIONAL CARE

Our highly professional, enthusiastic rehabilitation support workers are our most valued assets. All are qualified to QFCIII and have received accredited specialist training. Our slow stream rehabilitation service allows people the time they require to achieve their goals and increase their independence. Most of the clients who come to us will have already have had an acute period of rehabilitation. We will focus on maintaining and progressing quality of life, re-learning previously acquired skills, learning new skills, given a client's personal cognitive, motivational and behavioural situation.

After a two week adjustment period, where clients are closely monitored, our team prepare a care package, which is reviewed regularly. Clients and their families are fully consulted and encouraged to contribute their input to care arrangements.

Our rich schedule of regular and ad hoc activities gives our residents the opportunity to participate in their favourite pastimes, learn new skills, venture outdoors and keep their minds & bodies fit and alert.
